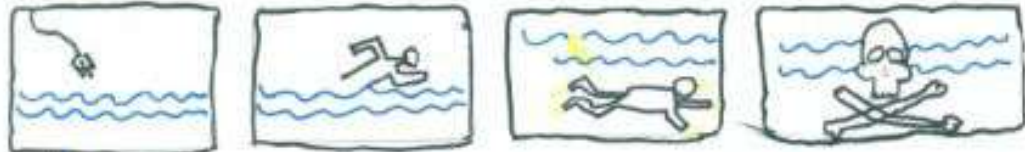

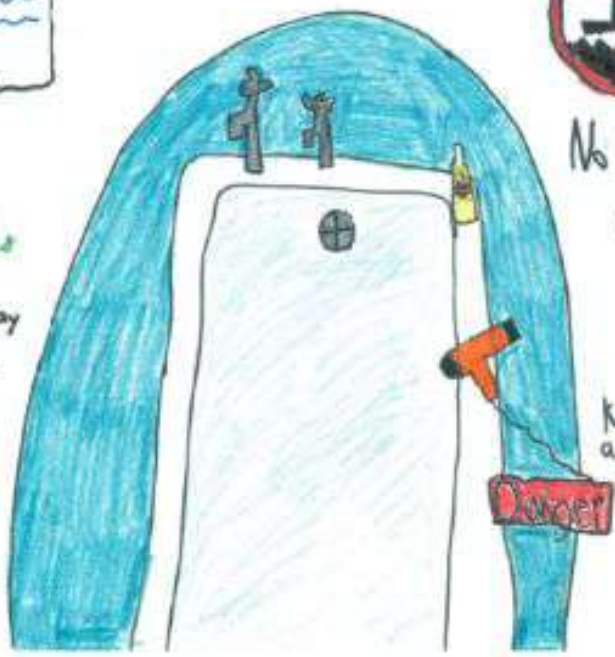
DONT MIX
