Welcome to the Safety Sleuth Program and Student Project. Fully funded by PSEG Long Island, this program is designed for grades 2-5 and is free to educators and students.

The Safety Sleuth program focuses on learning about safety and situational awareness with two lessons (multiple activities within each) and a culminating student project. These lessons are cross-curricular and can be effectively used across the curriculum. This project offers students an opportunity to share what they have learned, and teachers can use this as an assessment tool. Students will be thrilled to become “*Certified Safety Sleuths*”.
